

Staff Packing List

## The list indicates the kind and quantity of items the average staff member needs. Please use it as a guide. Important! <u>Everything</u> has to be labeled with your name!

2 blankets *
1 pillow*
4 twin-sized sheets*
3 pillow cases*
6 towels
2 wash cloths
1 bathrobe (optional)
1 pair of shower shoes/flip flops
1 heavy sweater or jacket
1 pair of sturdy shoes for hikes
2 pairs of sneakers
2-3 bathing suits
12 pairs of socks
2 pajamas; 1 light,1 heavy
2 pairs of jeans or pants
1 light colored, lightweight pair of pants for hikes
1 light colored, lightweight shirt for hikes
16 sets of underwear
6 pairs of shorts
1 raincoat or poncho with a hood or rain hat
1 pair of waterproof boots
12 t-shirts

3 white shirts for Shabbat (Everyone at Camp wears a white shirt for Friday night dinner and services. It can be a plain white t-shirt.) 2 sweatshirts or jacket 1-9 hats sleeping bag\* sunglasses soap, toothpaste, shampoo \*\* comb and brush toothbrush and holder sunscreen\*\* insect repellant (nontoxic preferred) \*\* flashlight with extra batteries laundry bag musical instrument (optional) reading material/quiet games (optional) posters/decorations for cabin (optional) digital camera (optional) soccer cleats (optional) softball glove (optional)

\*These items will be provided to all international staff members

\*\*There are stores and opportunities for staff to purchase any additional supplies that may not fit in your baggage or you have forgotten.

## Baggage:

- Label all luggage (including sleeping bags and hand luggage) with two sturdy name tags—one inside and one outside the bag—showing your name and address.
  - Please use suitcases and/or soft-sided duffel bags, no trunks.
  - Be kind to yourself, avoid very heavy bags. Use multiple bags instead.

## Laundry:

- Laundry service is provided once each week. It is not recommended for delicate, expensive, or never-before-washed clothing. Camp is not responsible for lost or damaged clothing.
- Additionally, coin operated washing machines and dryers are available for staff use.

## Leave at Home:

- Prohibited: Fireworks, drugs, alcohol, matches, weapons, or other dangerous instruments. Large fans, appliances for heating food, knives, music with violent, sexual, or profane lyrics.
- Recommended to avoid: Hair dryers, jewelry, expensive clothing, expensive electronic games/equipment.
- Food or candy is permitted if it is **nut and tree-nut free**.
