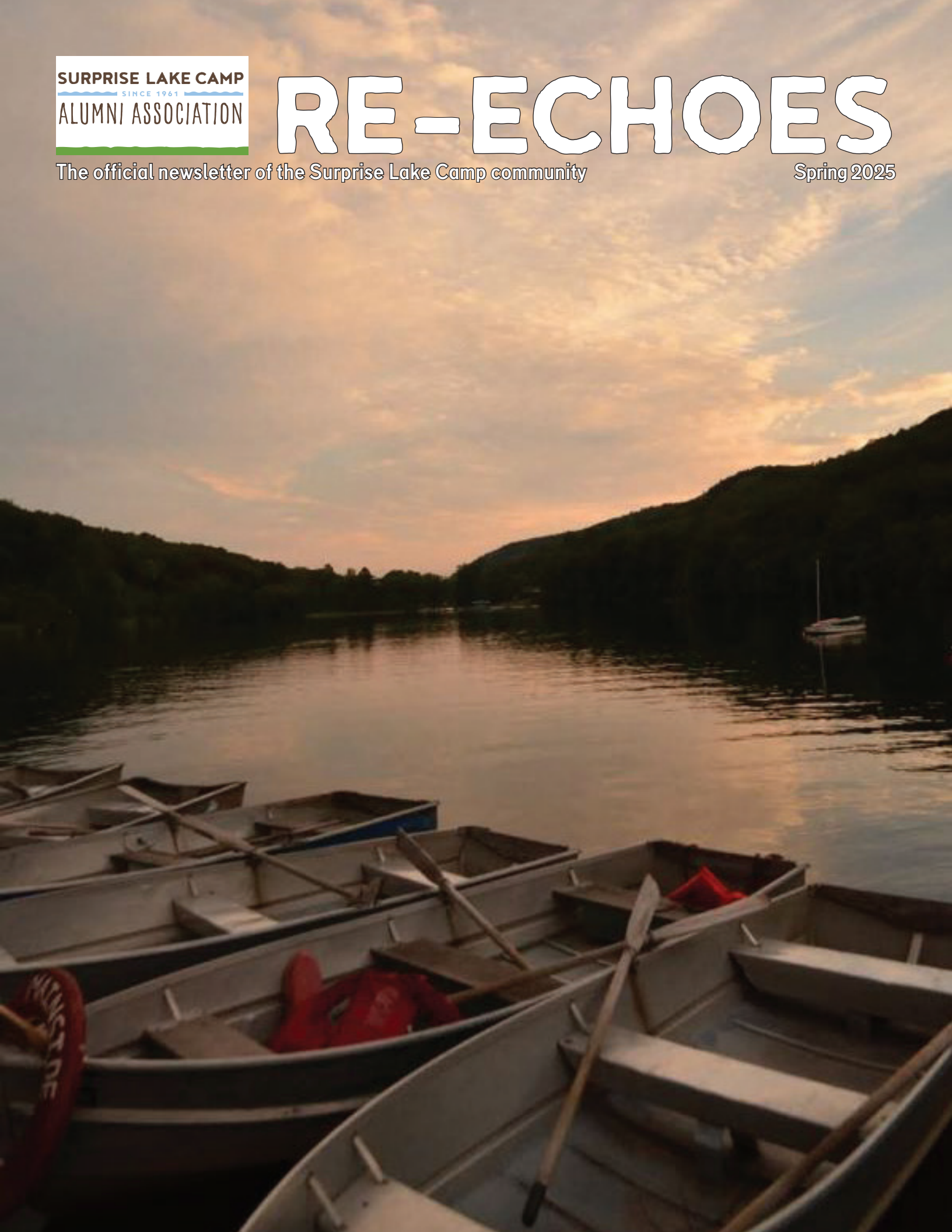

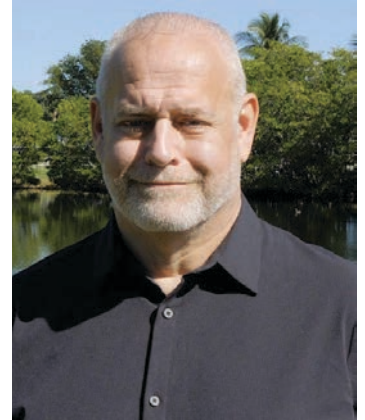

To Our Dear Alumni,

Surprise Lake Camp continues to be a home away from home for thousands of campers and staff who have joined us for one – or several – transformational summers over the last century. Experiences, for many, only made possible through the generosity of our most dedicated friends and supporters like you. To create that familiar feeling of home, we rely on tradition coupled with exciting new opportunities to reinforce cornerstone Jewish celebrations and customs, as well as weave traditional Israeli culture into our unique program. This year, we are looking to coordinate and implement even more cultural practices and Jewish tradition at Surprise Lake Camp, to educate the campers of today, who will become the Jewish leaders of tomorrow.

Many of the core ideals of this cultural infusion are grounded in Judaism’s 613 Mitzvot. Embodying the Torah, these commandments continue to permeate today’s Israeli culture and outline best practices in everything from family life and property ownership to business ethics, nutrition, philanthropy, and fashionable clothing. Looking back to traditional Mitzvot, we continue to weave cultural routines into our regular schedule. For example, each week on Friday evenings and Saturday mornings, Shabbat is observed at the Eddie Cantor Theater overlooking beautiful Lake Surprise, while learning the Torah, singing joyous tunes, and celebrating our fellow community members during Shabbat Walk. Observance happens more than once weekly, however. Three times daily, after washing hands, the community gathers to help prepare and eat three “square” kosher meals, over which prayers are said, and we appreciate all that took place to bring nourishment to our tables. Another one of the 613 Mitzvot that is oft overlooked, but inherent in summer camp, is to teach children to navigate choppy waters – both figuratively and literally – which is fulfilled programmatically through our Red Cross swim instruction. This leaves our campers more knowledgeable, skilled, and confident than when they began.

To ensure we meet campers at their own level in this ever-changing world, we must also look for new opportunities to carry out traditions. Because there are so many Mitzvot, there is a great deal of opportunity for continued incorporation. You, yes you, will also have a special opportunity to take part in bringing the 613 Mitzvot to life at SLC this fall – be on the lookout for more information on that soon! In the meantime, we invite you to continue your generous support with a gift to the Annual Drive so we can continue to build innovative programs and opportunities for our future Jewish leaders. Thank you for continuing to support our home away from home.
