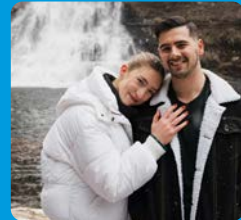

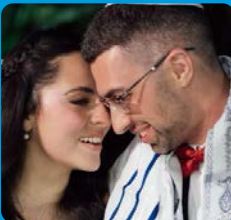

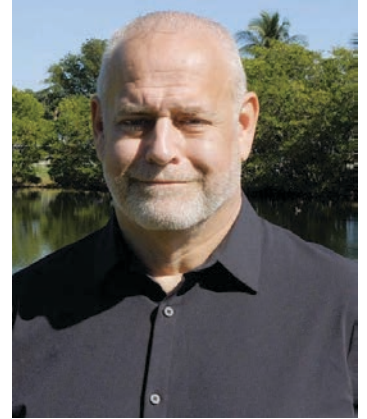

Spring Appeal

Since 1902, Surprise Lake Camp has been a haven for children, a beacon of joy and growth where young individuals explore their identities, make lifelong friendships, and deepen their connection with Jewish traditions; it is hailed as an oasis that fosters and celebrates the values of grit, gratitude, compassion, and courage all within the warm embrace of our community.
